Leaders from AI, Arts Education, Tech and Nonprofit Join OFJCC Board of Directors

Palo Alto, CA—August 29, 2024—The Oshman Family Jewish Community Center, one of the nation's leading Jewish institutions and a premier venue in Silicon Valley for learning, wellness and the arts, this month inaugurated its 2024–2025 Board of Directors. The new slate of directors, hailing from across the arts education, software and artificial intelligence sectors, reflects the way in which the Oshman Family JCC has become one of Silicon Valley's most desirable nonprofit Board seats.

Lauren Berman, also appointed Vice Chair, returning for her second stint on the Oshman Family JCC Board. Berman has worked in leadership and management positions in nonprofit development, human resources, medical administration, communication consulting and theatre education. Berman also previously served the Oshman Family JCC professionally as the Director of Early Childhood Education. Berman is a founder of an alternative Jewish education theatre program and a city producer for the Jewish Plays Project, and has previously served on the boards of TheatreWorks Silicon Valley and NIMBLE Mindset.

Amir Faintuch, also returning to the Board for the second time. Faintuch is the Chief Executive Officer at Volumez, which transforms cloud data infrastructure for modern workloads. Prior to joining Volumez, Faintuch held senior executive management positions spanning technical and business responsibilities at leading technology companies, including GlobalFoundries, Intel, Qualcomm and Texas Instruments. In addition to his previous service on the Oshman Family JCC Board, Faintuch has also served on the Steering Committee for ICON, the Israeli Collaboration Network, since 2014.

Jennifer Miller, General Counsel of Grammarly, the AI software company whose mission is to improve lives through communication. During her legal career, Miller has served as General Counsel to a number of disruptive technology companies, including Starship Technologies and Loon, the Alphabet moonshot company, and in a variety of roles at Cisco, HP and

on the Board of Leading Women in Technology, a nonprofit focused on women's professional and leadership development.

Jody Shapiro, co-founder and Chief Executive Officer at Productiv, a software platform that helps IT and finance leaders collaborate in managing their growing SaaS portfolios using data, analytics, workflows and artificial intelligence to drive efficiency in their SaaS spend. Prior to founding Productiv, Shapiro led Google's enterprise marketing analytics platform, Google Analytics 360, as well as Product Management for Google TV Ads. Prior to Google, Shapiro was part of the founding team at TiVo Greater China and held leadership roles at technology companies including Silicon Graphics and PictureTel, as well as multiple startups.

Zack Bodner, President and Chief Executive Officer of the Oshman Family JCC, expressed excitement about the new leadership. "We are thrilled to have such incredible talent joining us on the Board. Both our brand new Board members Jennifer and Jody, and our returning members, Lauren and Amir, bring tremendous expertise, insight and deep commitment at a vital moment in the evolution of the organization."

For over 30 years, he has provided cross-functional business leadership to high-growth technology companies, and was past Board President at Congregation B'nai Emunah in San Francisco. Tachner, who holds bachelor's degrees in electrical engineering and social science, as well as an MBA and J.D., previously held both Corporate Development and General Counsel roles at Atheros Communications, now a division of Qualcomm, Google's Access division and earlier at fabless MEMS leader InvenSense, now the sensor division of TDK.

The new Board of Directors convenes on September 11.
